Kia ora Parents, Caregivers and Whanau,

As we are now in Level 2 the government identifies that we have increased risk levels due to community transmission with COVID-19. We need to be vigilant to ensure the ongoing health and safety of all students and staff.

## Students who are unwell must stay at home

Because of the high risk level to students and staff if there was to be a case of COVID-19 within Ferndale School the Board and the School Leadership have decided that students who are unwell must be kept at home.

# **Students with COVID-19 symptoms**

If a child/young person becomes unwell at school, the child/young person will need to be uplifted immediately. If the child/young person has flu or cold like symptoms including a runny nose, sore throat, headache and fever the Board and School Leadership will require that the child/young person either undergo a COVID-19 assessment and provide a negative result on this assessment or get a medical certificate stating that they are well and can attend school before they can return to schooling on site. If a child/young person gets a positive result on a COVID -19 assessment they will be unable to return to schooling on site until they have a negative assessment for COVID-19.

### If a person is tested for COVID-19 in a student's home

If a person in a Ferndale student's home needs to undergo a test for COVID-19 the Board and School Leadership require that the child/young person is kept home until a negative result from the COVID-19 test is received. If a positive result is received the child/young person will be unable to return to schooling on site until the person within their home receives a negative assessment for COVID-19.

# Other illness

Should a child/young person have any other illness the Board and School Leadership will follow the Infectious Diseases Chart to identify the length of time a student will need to be away from school while they recover from their illness.

It is critical that we keep all students and staff safe during COVID-19 Level 2. The Board and Staff of Ferndale School appreciate your support and understanding.
